ARTICLE 36 (p)	Helper rates shall be a minimum of fifty-five percent (55%) of the applicable mechanic's rate per hour.		
ARTICLE 36 (q)	The Contractor shall pay the Helper listed rate for Apprenticeship, MOST, Pension and National Annuity contributions on individuals working within this classification.
